Computer Access & WiFi

Delegates at WCDC2018 can access PCs and printing services in a computer room [Arts PACR] located in the Arts Block on the North Campus, close to the main conference venues. On entering the building from the main concourse, take a left as you come in the door, follow the wall down to the end, past the public seating area in the centre of the building. This room [Arts PACR] is open from 9am-10pm Mon-Friday and a computing assistant is on site to provide support.

The Maynooth University Wireless SSID connects you to a free, open (unencrypted) wireless network which allows access to some local resources without the need to authenticate.

- Restricted services: http, https, SSL-VPN(443).
- Email clients (Thunderbird, Outlook) will not work on this network.
- Unsecured network - no default data encryption.
- Access to Maynooth University WiFi may be restricted.

Eduroam SSID is also available on campus and we recommend that those of you who are registered, via your home institution, to use this network. If you have difficulty with access, the University computer centre have provided guest login details.

Food off-campus:

Maynooth is a small but bustling town and there are many restaurants and cafes located along the main street. Within 800 meters of the University gate, you will find Chinese, Japanese, Mexican, Vegan and more traditional Irish cuisine. Restaurant prices vary but it is certainly possible to find a filling main course from €10 upwards. There are food counters located in a number of the small supermarkets along the main street, where you can buy hot or cold sandwiches and other pre-cooked food to take away. This can be a cheaper option with prices starting from €5 upwards. Finally, there are a number of larger supermarkets located in the vicinity of the University: Dunnes Stores; SuperValu & Tesco. There are cooking facilities available to delegates staying in the Apartments on the North Campus.

Shop

There is a mini supermarket in the John Hume Building providing basic toiletries, snacks, tea and coffee open from 9am-3pm Mon to Friday. The University bookshop is in the John Hume Building.
